BOTH JOB READINESS PROGRAMS CONTINUE TO IMPROVE



LEARNING AS WE GO has been our mode of operation since 2014. If we had waited until we figured it all out and had everything well planned, we'd still be sitting at my kitchen table talking about what we *could* accomplish.

Although the need for our type of services is evident, what's not so obvious is the financial need and volunteer need in supporting both job readiness programs at two facilities. We continue to operate by faith, relying on God to influence new ministry partners to give of their time, talent and treasure.

We would love to add more supporters as personal shoppers and inventory assistants at Amelia's Closet, along with lunch volunteers at Liberty's Station Thursdays through Saturdays. Our schedules are flexible with both monthly, bi-monthly and weekly commitments and timeframes.

We believe our programs are wonderful environments in which to spend time serving our community. Our volunteers always seem to have great ideas to help us improve our services and streamline our processes. PROGRAM IMPACT:

LIBERTY'S STATION has been open for lunch since Nov. 2022. Currently we have fifteen paid interns. Seven interns have already transitioned to community employment and three interns are finalizing their resumes in order to apply for employment.

AMELIA'S CLOSET continues to serve women weekly. We have assisted over 600 women and the majority of appointments are for week's wardrobes instead of interview outfits, since many of them in securing employment prior to their appointment.
